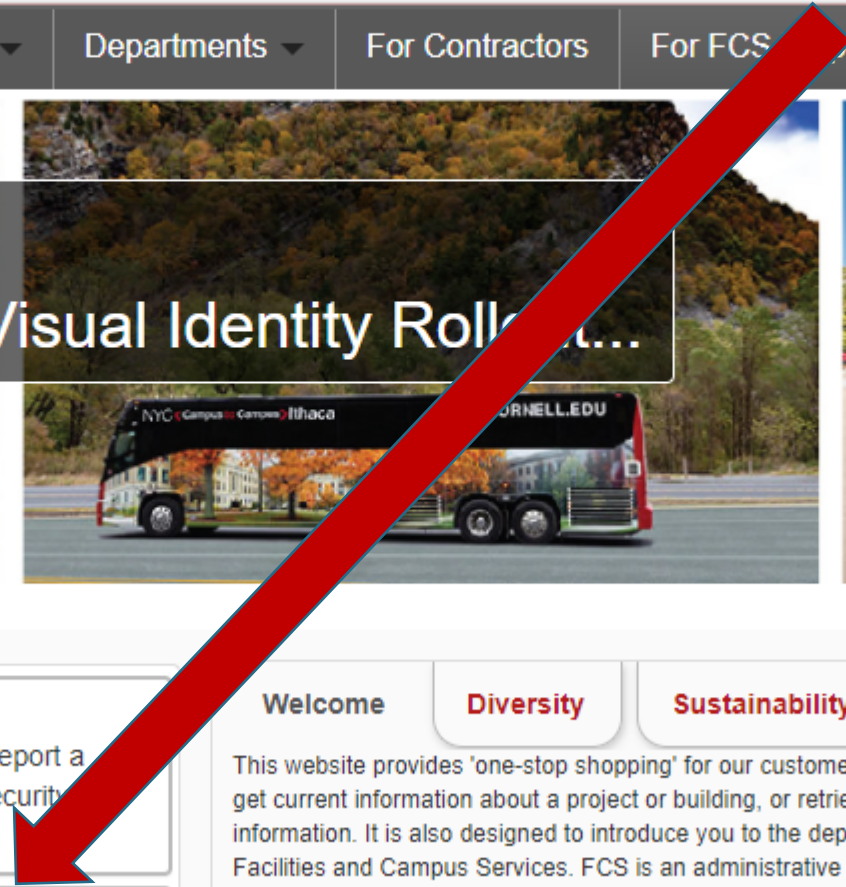

# *Exciting comments on Design Standards*



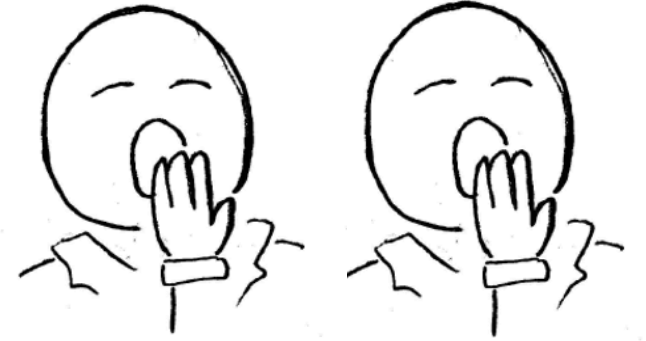
**Standards are...**

- Instructions to Design Teams (**NOT** contractors)
- Clarification of standard campus practices, information for connections to infrastructure, required minimums & design intentions...

**Standards are NOT...**

- Contract Specifications (but may be basis for design team's specifications)
- Cornell's design for contractors (rather they inform and set minimal standards for the design team to create their own design)

# *Even more exciting Design Details!*



## Design Details...

- **Show expectations** for level of design
- **Clarify** how certain standards are to be **applied** (example: controls)

## Design Details are **not**...

- All applicable to every project (use only ones applicable)
- Suitable for simple “cut-and-paste” (without designer’s review and tailoring for each project)
- A way for designers to avoid design responsibility – **designer remains responsible** for all final design!
